



24 Hours of Homestake

**Saturday August 31st –
September 1st 2013

RACE DESCRIPTION:

The 24 Hours of Homestake will be held from noon August 31st – noon September 1st. Racers may either compete as individuals or in teams of any size, up to eight. Each lap is approximately 7 miles in length. Racers will have 24 hours to complete as many laps as possible. The terrain is a mix of logging roads, trails, and single track suitable for most riders.

DIRECTIONS:

To get to Homestake Lodge, take the Homestake exit from I-90 at the top of Homestake pass and turn south for a short distance, turn onto FS 240 road for 3 miles, paralleling I-90 eastward. The road is manageable for most vehicles. Post race awards will be done at the lodge.

Registration & Pricing:

Solo- \$75	Late Registration - \$100
Duo - \$150	Late Registration - \$200
4 person - \$250	Late Registration - \$300
8 person - \$500	Late Registration - \$600

Teams with participants in between categories will be scored and priced as next largest team. Pre-registration available at www.usacycling.com and must be received by Saturday August 24th, 2013. Packet pick-up and late registration available Thursday August 29th from 7-9 in the south end of the Student Union Building. Additional packet pick up will be available at 9:00am 8/31 morning of the race.

PRIZES:

Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd men and women in the solo category and 1st, 2nd, 3rd in the two person relay category. 1st place prizes will be awarded to the 4 person and 8 person teams whom will be scored equally regardless of exclusive male or female teams. Must be present at award ceremony to receive prizes.
