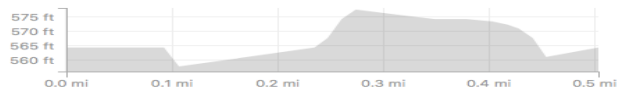
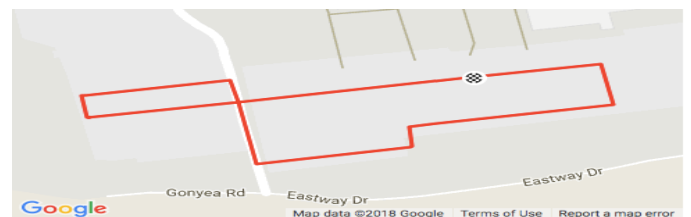
(from University of Oregon campus):
